No synonym is officially recognized in France, nor in other countries of the European Union.

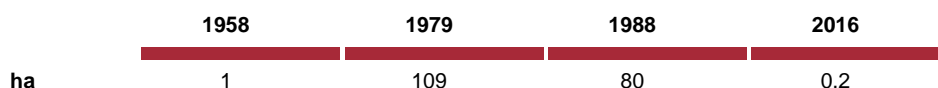

Description

Identification signs include:

- the tip of the young shoot has a very thick coat of flat-lying hairs,
- the young leaves are green with bronze patches,
- adult leaves are orbicular, whole or 3-lobed with shallow lateral sinuses, an open petiolar sinus, short teeth; short to moderate size teeth with straight or convex edges; a flat and slightly wavy leaf blade and the underside with a moderate to thick coat of upright and flat-lying hairs,
- elliptical-shaped berries.

Phenology

Bud burst: 8 days after Chasselas.
Grape maturity: period III, 4 and 1/2 to 5 weeks after Chasselas.

Suitability for cultivation and agronomic production

Arrouya N has good vigor, not very fertile when short-pruned but which becomes fairly productive when long pruned. Due to its late nature, it must be planted in hot climate zones.

Sensitivity to diseases and pests

Arrouya N is a little sensitive to grey rot (compact grape clusters).

Technological potential

Grape clusters are moderate size and compact while the berries are very small to small. Arrouya N produces common wines, rather acid, not very colorful but astringent with sometimes slight bitter notes.

Clonal selection in France

The only approved Arrouya N clone carries the number 1112.
