Origin

This variety is originally from the north east of France (Aube) based on published genetic analyses and was derived from the crossbreeding of Gouais B and Pinot.

Synonymy

No synonym is officially recognized in France, nor in other countries of the European Union.

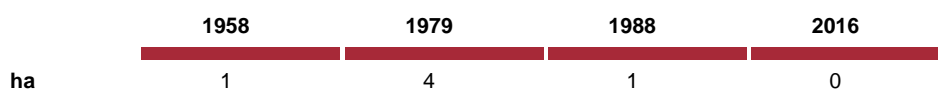

Description

Identification signs include:

- the tip of the young shoot has a very heavy coat of flat-lying hairs,
- the shoot has red striped internodes,
- adult leaves are whole with an open V or U-shaped petiolar sinus, moderate teeth with straight sides, moderate anthocyanin pigmentation, involute leaf blade, sometimes slightly upturned on the edges, finely bubbled and the underside with a sparse to moderate coat of flat-lying hairs,
- elliptical-shaped berries.

Phenology

Bud burst: 3 days before Chasselas.

Grape maturity: period I, 1 to 1 and 1/2 weeks after Chasselas.

Suitability for cultivation and agronomic production

This variety has good vigor and is fairly productive. It appears to resist well against winter freeze. On the other hand, it is sensitive to chlorosis and has a potential to being affected by drought and root asphyxia.

Sensitivity to diseases and pests

Bachet N is susceptible to the main diseases: downy mildew, powdery mildew, grey rot.

Technological potential

The grape clusters and berries are small. Bachet N produces fairly common wine, relatively alcoholic and acid with herbaceous character.

Clonal selection in France

There are no approved clones for this variety at the present time.
