This variety is originally from the south west of France.

Description

Identification signs include:

- the tip of the young shoots have a heavy coat of flat-lying hairs,
- the young leaves are green,
- adult leaves are moderate in size, 3-lobed with a petiolar sinus with a U-shaped base, open; small teeth, long compared to width at base with straight sides, moderate anthocyanin pigmentation of veins; a slightly wavy leaf blade, sometimes cupped and the underside with a slight coat of upright hairs and a moderate to heavy coat of flat-lying hairs,
- round-shaped berries.

Phenology

Bud burst: 5 days after Chasselas.

Grape maturity: period II, 3 and 1/2 weeks after Chasselas.

Suitability for cultivation and agronomic production

Bouillet N is very fertile even when short pruned. The shoots grow semi-erect.

Sensitivity to diseases and pests

Bouillet N is susceptible to grey rot.

Technological potential

Grape clusters and berries are large. Bouillet N produces low quality, oftentimes acid and somewhat bitter wines.

Clonal selection in France

There are no approved clones for this variety at the present time.
