Description

The description corresponds to Chasselas B, except for the berry flavor when ripe is slightly muscat flavored.

Phenology

Bud burst: 2 days before Chasselas B.
Grape maturity: period I, same as Chasselas B.

Suitability for cultivation and agronomic production

The aptitudes of Chasselas Muscat B are comparable to Chasselas B.

Sensitivity to diseases and pests

The response to disease is similar to Chasselas B.

Technological potential

The grape clusters and berries are small to moderate size.

Clonal selection in France

There are no approved clones for this variety at the present time.
