Colobel

Origin

Colobel N or 8357 Seibel (an interspecific hybrid) comes from the crossbreeding of 6150 Seibel and Plantet N (or 5455 Seibel).

Synonymy

In France, this variety can officially be called "8357 Seibel" for plant propagation material.

In France, Colobel N is officially listed in the "Catalogue of vine varieties".

Description

Identification signs include:

- the tips of the young shoot has a slight coat of flat-lying hairs,
- the young leaves are green with reddish patches,
- adult leaves are orbicular, whole with a slightly open V-shaped petiolar sinus, moderate size teeth with straight sides, an upturned leaf blade, shiny; bubbled, slightly cupped near the petiolar point which reddens in the autumn and the underside with an absence or very slight coat of flat-lying and upright hairs,
- the berries are round-shaped and the pulp is slighted colored.

Phenology

Bud burst: 2 days after Chasselas.

Grape maturity: period III, 4 weeks after Chasselas.

Suitability for cultivation and agronomic production

Colobel N has moderate vigor and grows upright to semi-upright. It can be managed and long pruned.

Sensitivity to diseases and pests

Colobel N is not very affected by downy mildew but is susceptible to anthracnosis and should preferably be grafted.

Technological potential

The grape clusters are moderate size, compact and the berries are likewise moderate in size. Colobel N produces fairly colored, very mediocre quality wines with the presence diglucoside anthocyanes.

Clonal selection in France

There are no clones for this variety at the present time.
