Franc noir de la Haute-Saône

Origin

This variety is originally from the east of France and based on published genetic analyses, is the result of the crossbreeding of Pinot noir N and Gouais B.

Synonymy

No synonym is officially recognized in France, nor in other countries of the European Union.

In France, Franc noir de la Haute-Saône N is officially listed in the "Catalogue of vine varieties"

Description

Identification signs include:

- the tips of the young shoot have a heavy coat of flat-lying hairs,
- the young leaves are green with bronze patches,
- the shoots have red internodes,
- adult leaves are large, orbicular, whole, 3 or 5 lobes with a closed petiolar sinus with slightly overlapping lobes, lateral sinuses with a U-shaped base, short teeth compared to width at base, straight or convex sides, a jagged leaf blade, revolute, wavy between the veins near the petiolar point and the underside with a slight coat of upright and flat-lying hairs,
- round-shaped berries.

Phenology

Bud burst: 5 days after Chasselas.

Grape maturity: period I, 1/2 to 1 week after Chasselas.

Suitability for cultivation and agronomic production

Franc noir de la Haute-Saône N is an early, vigorous, fertile and constant vine variety.

Sensitivity to diseases and pests

Franc noir de la Haute-Saône N is rather sensitive to downy mildew. On the other hand, it is not very affected by grey rot.

Technological potential

Grape clusters and berries are small. Franc noir de la Haute-Saône N produces satisfactory quality wine.

Clonal selection in France

The only approved Franc noir de la Haute-Saône N clone carries the number 1226. Surveys have recently been carried out in the north east of France.
