### Description

Identification signs include:

- the tips of the young shoots have a heavy coat of flat-lying hairs,
- the young leaves are green or yellow with bronze patches,
- orbicular or pentagonal shaped adult leaves, whole or with 3 lobes, a slightly open or V-shaped petiolar sinus or with slightly overlapping lobes, short teeth compared to width at base, straight sides, an absence of anthocyanin coloration of veins, a strongly bubbled leaf blade, wavy between the veins, sometimes lightly cupped and the underside with a sparse coat of flat-lying hairs,
- round-shaped berries.

## Phenology

Bud burst: days before Chasselas.  
Grape maturity: period II, 2 weeks after Chasselas.

## Suitability for cultivation and agronomic production

Négret de Banhars N is fairly vigorous and grows semi-erect. The shoots are fragile with regard to wind. Grape cluster stalks are very short which makes manual grape harvesting delicate.

## Sensitivity to diseases and pests

Due to the compact nature of the grape clusters and the fragile skins, Négret de Banhars N is susceptible to grey rot and it is likewise susceptible to excoriosis.

## Technological potential

Grape clusters are moderate in size and the berries are small to moderate size. The skin is very colored and gives the wine a deep color. The wines produces are not very tannic and not very alcoholic.

## Clonal selection in France

There are no approved clones for this vine variety at the present time. A conservatory with 20 clones was set up in 2005 in the Aveyron region.
