In France, this variety can officially be called "Heunisch Weiss" or "Branco Valente" regarding plant propagation material. In Germany, Gouais blanc can officially be designated as "Weisser Heunisch".

In France, Gouais blanc is officially listed in the "Catalogue of vine varieties" since 2021 on the A list. This variety is also listed in the catalogue of Germany and Switzerland.
