Descriptive elements

The description corresponds to that of Italia, except for the skin color of the berries, which is in this case red when ripe.

Phenology

Bud burst: 6 days after Chasselas.
Grape maturity: late-season, 4 weeks after Chasselas.

Suitability for cultivation and agronomic production

Italia Rubi is sensitive to millerandage and slightly sensitive to desiccation of the stems. It is a vigorous variety, with a semi-erect bearing, that must be trained and pruned long.

Susceptibility to diseases and pests

Italia Rubi is sensitive to downy mildew and grey rot.

Technological potentiality

The bunches are large, conical-shaped and moderately compact. The berries are also large but sometimes, the size and color are not homogeneous. The skin is moderately thick and the pulp is fleshy. The flavor is pleasant, slightly muscaté.

Clonal selection in France

The only certified Italia Rubi clone carries the number 1122.
